Ravi Bharwani graduated in 1990, from the Cinematography Department of the Faculty of Film and Television, Jakarta Art Institute (IKJ). He was later involved in a number of commercials, documentaries, short films and a Television film. Most of his documentaries focused on the lives of children in remote areas of the country.

**“Impian Kemarau” (“The Rainmaker”)**, his first feature film, premiered in the ‘Asian New Currents’ section in the 9<sup>th</sup> Pusan International Film Festival, 2004. The film travelled to numerous film festivals and received the Best Film – Asia New Talent Award at the 8<sup>th</sup> Shanghai International Film Festival, in 2005.

For his second feature – **“Jermal”**, he worked along with 2 other directors – Rayya Makarim and Utawa Tresno. This film had its World Premiere in the ‘A Window on Asian Cinema’ section at the 13<sup>th</sup> Pusan International Film Festival, 2008. He is currently writing his next feature film.
