– A documentary about Special Olympics Indonesia

Brief Synopsis

A 25-minutes documentary made for the organization SOINA (Special Olympics Indonesia). In November 2008, SOINA held their annual national games in Jakarta. Participants come from all over Indonesia, two of them are Aswin and Nadziroh. We follow their struggle, their journey to the game, and to victory.

Complete Synopsis

The documentary follows the adventures of one official and two participants from East Java province. Mrs. Rina is the chief coordinator of Special Olympics Indonesia East Java; Nadziroh (12 years old) is an athlete in the basketball team; and Aswin (17 years old) is an athlete in the swimming team.

We follow their preparation to the games in Jakarta. We show how the athletes exercise, the support of their parents, and the dedication of the official. We show them at work, on the field; and we show them outside work, at home or on other activities. We show the excitement towards the game in Jakarta, the travel, and the event itself. We show them in competition, and we show them getting rewarded for their effort.
